Gilbert de Clare, 4th Earl of Hertford, 5th Earl of Gloucester (1180-1230) = Isabel Marshal
Richard de Clare, 5th Earl of Hertford, 6th Earl of Gloucester (1222-1262) = Maud de Lacy
Thomas de Clare, Lord of Thomond (c. 1245-1287) = Juliana FitzMaurice (d.o. Maurice FitzGerald)
Bartholomew de Badlesmere, 1st Baron Badlesmere (1275-1322) = Margaret de Clare (1287-1333)
William de Ros, 2nd Lord de Ros of Helmsley (c. 1285-1343) = Margery de Badlesmere (1306-1363)

Nicholas Wilkinson of Harperley (or Harpley) House, Kyo, nr. Lanchester, Co. Durham (1590-before 1640) (arms granted to his father, Laurence Wilkinson of Harperley (or Harpley) House, Kyo, nr. Lanchester, Co. Durham, and The Manor House, Ferye-on-the-Hill (Ferryhill), Co. Durham, in 1615) = Barbara Sotheron
Robert Wilkinson of Harperley (or Harpley) House, Kyo, nr. Lanchester, Co. Durham = (1681) Mercy Grey of Southwick, Co. Durham
